Looking for a new place to explore this winter that is close to home? The 75-acre Driggers Preserve, located on the Charlevoix-Boyer City Road (about five miles west of Horton Bay) includes 1.5 miles of mixed terrain trail that offer excellent cross-country skiing and snowshoeing. The trails wind through northern hardwoods, pine plantations, meadows, and along a small stream providing nice views of Lake Charlevoix in a few spots. Join staff from Little Traverse Conservancy during this Winter Fling Open House. There will be hot beverages, snacks, and a bonfire. Ski or snowshoe the trails on your own, or with a Conservancy guide. There's a full moon that night, so come late for a moonlight outing!
