Johnston Nature Preserve



Elmer Johnston Nature Preserve:

Once tilled farmland and more recently used for pasture, the 220-acre Johnston Preserve boasts a rolling hardwood forest and meadowland. Beech, sugar maple, and red oak dominate the hardwood forest. The hilltops offer magnificent views of Lake Michigan and Beaver Island. Mrs. Elmer Johnston donated this property in memory of her husband in 1982. No established trails exist at this time, but old logging trails wander through the property as shown on the map.



Directions to the Johnston Preserve:

From Harbor Springs, take State Road approximately 9.5 miles to Robinson Road. Turn left on Robinson and travel 4 miles to Church Road. Take a right onto Church and travel 1/2 mile to the Johnston Preserve on the right.
